The instructions are too generic and written for too many variations of Bonsai so there is no way to know which seeds are provided until it's too late - you've already killed whatever was growing because the instructions were not written for the seeds you have. I've tried this kit and 1 other type, but tried no less than 6 times and only once was I able to get the plant to grow a couple of branches before it died. And germinating the seeds is SO wrong in the instructions. Only because I've done a lot of seed germinating did I give up with the instructions and decide to do it "my" way - which worked. But the plant still didn't survive. I'm convinced that starting with a seedling is the only way to grow Bonsai. From a seed in a kit you'll always be guessing how to grow the sucker. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
