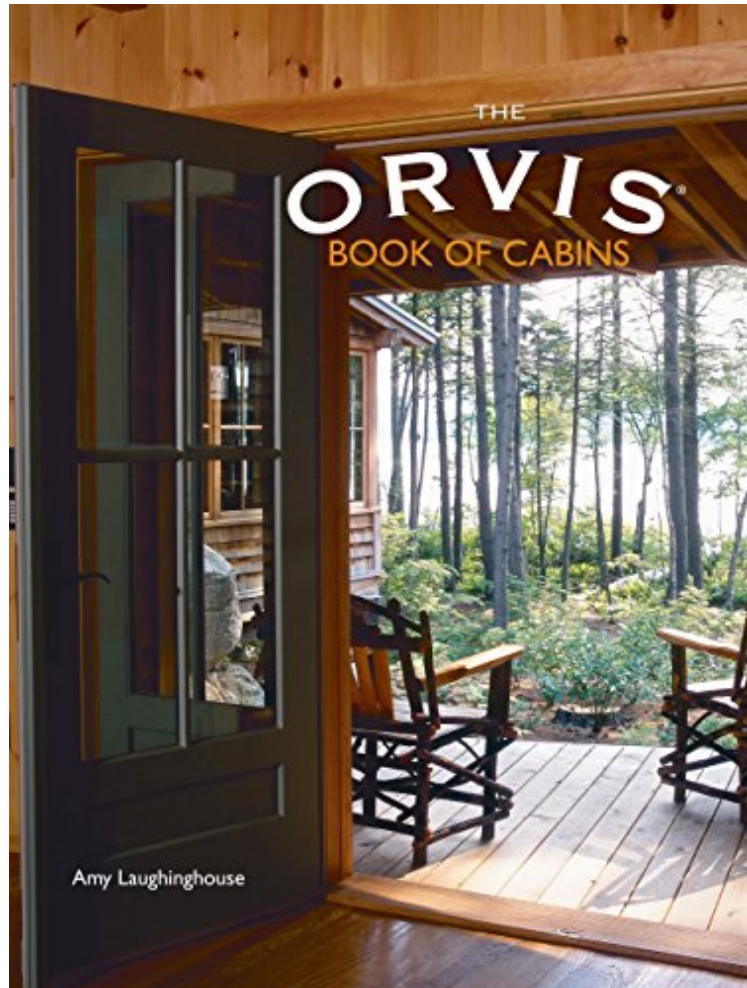

One is that most of the cabins just didn't appeal to me (that's admittedly a personal taste, and I did like two or three of the homes); the second, and more important reason, is that there are no floor plans of any of the cabins featured. There are also very few exterior photographs (one or two for each of the cabins), so it comes

across a bit like an "interiors books". Without floor plans or enough exterior photos it's hard to understand the design of the individual cabins. Very frustrating. I wish I could say I loved the book, but I just didn't. For me it was more or less a waste of money. I almost gave it 2-stars.
