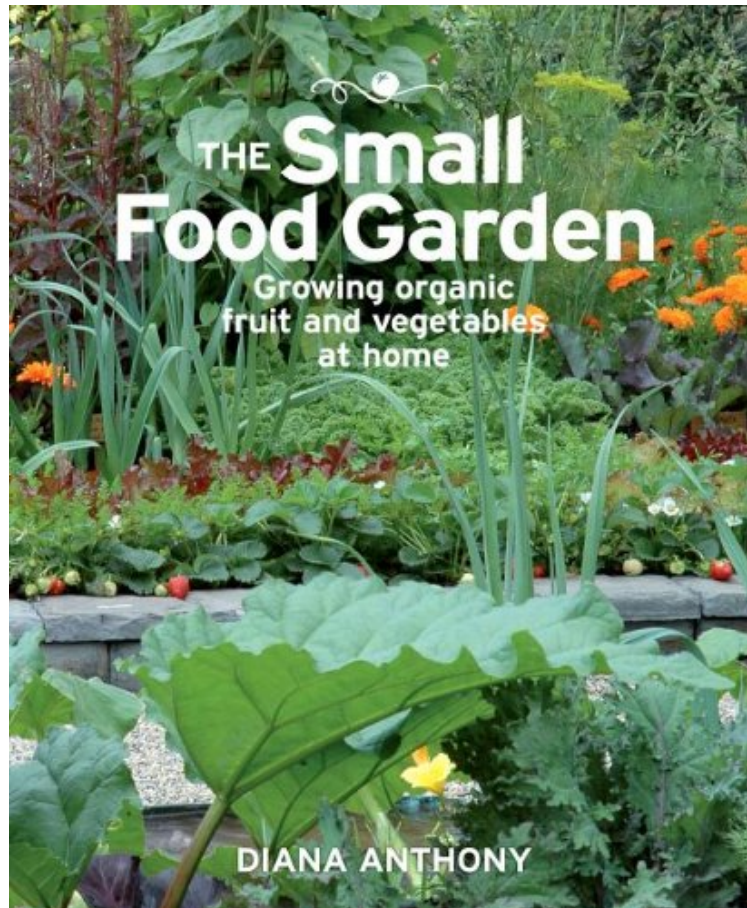

Too basicBy DavisDadI'm a beginning gardner and was looking for an expert's advice on specifics of organic farming such as how to arrange specific plants in relation to each other and crop rotation in a small bed. There is very little information on either of these matters - just 1 page, for example, on crop rotation. Chapters are filled with obvious information (e.g. "Growing edibles in colder climates" begins with "situate your garden in a warm sheltered spot"... use protection cloths... etc.) A huge section contains an encyclopedia of plant names with general characteristics and planting tips... nothing I couldn't find on the seed packet or on line. Much of the advice on going organic consists of the obvious: avoid chemical pesticides, pick disease-resistance varieties, etc. The particulars about specific non-chemical pesticides would be available from my local store, according

to what they had in stock, so a few pages on this subject also left me underwhelmed.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
