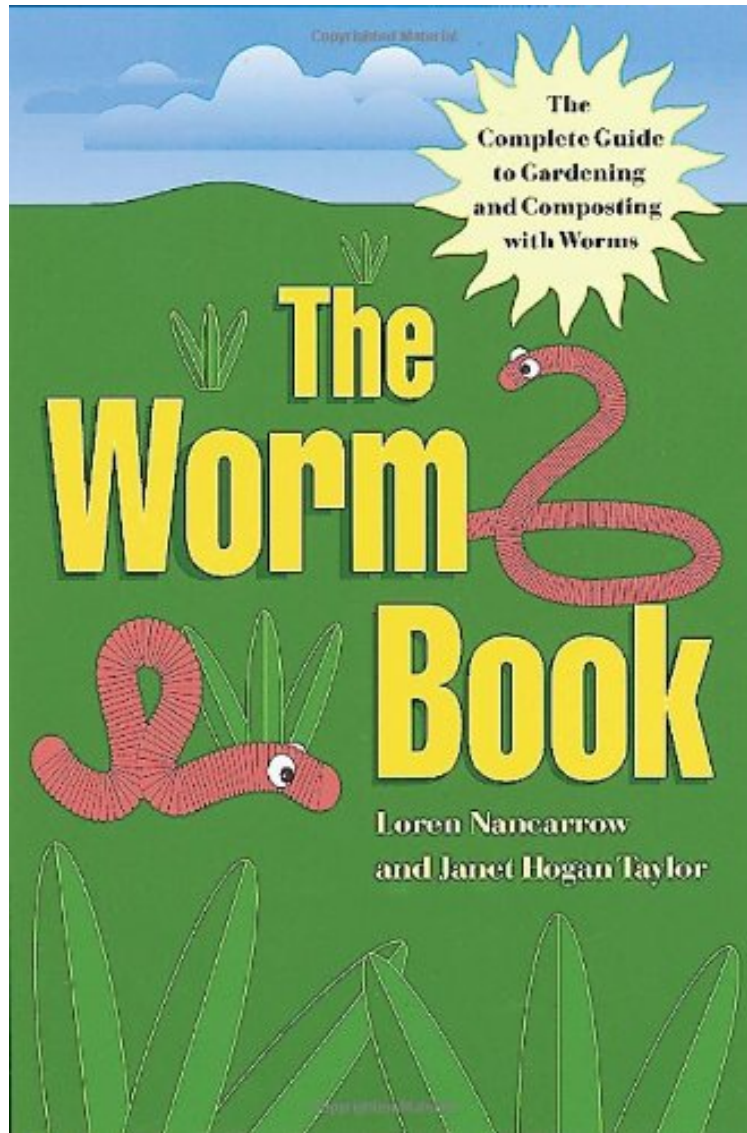

you'll need additional plans if you wish to make your own bin. Details could be more robust, for example how much water typically is needed to hydrate bedding.
