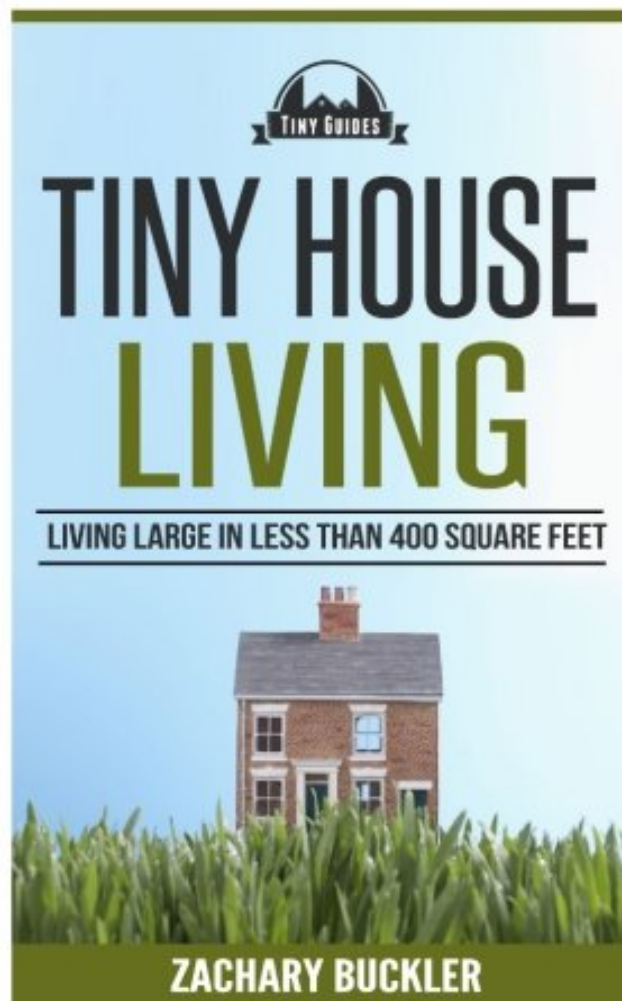

explanations of trademark ownership. The rest of the "book", more like a pamphlet, reads like an average blog post at best. The checklist contains about three items, and there's really nothing usable, interesting, or compelling at all here. The author probably spent about 3 1/2 hours working on this at most by my estimation. Maybe less. The writing is piss poor. An example: "Just when you thought tiny houses couldn't look any much better because of their small spaces, think again. Here are some of the most wonderfully designs tiny houses there is, and see for yourself how a space that small can look so spacious and big." As for tips, he informs us that murphy beds, lazy susans, and magnets are key elements for maximizing space. Genius stuff here.
