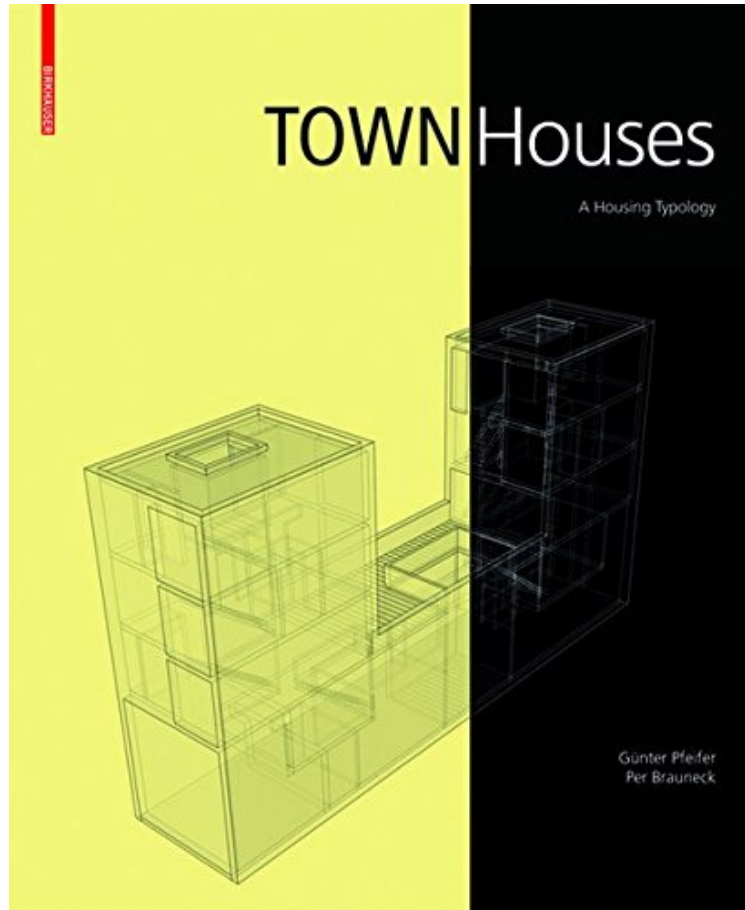

The underlying social attitudes on which the buildings are based are Eurocentric with smaller and fewer bathrooms, often no dedicated laundry room, and other differences from U.S. practice. I find the overview and organization of the material useful. This is one of several similar books I look at repeatedly as an aid to thinking about housing.

The third volume of this typology of residential buildings deals with the different types of the townhouse. The authors present them according to urban constellation: row, twin-row, block perimeter and infill sites.
