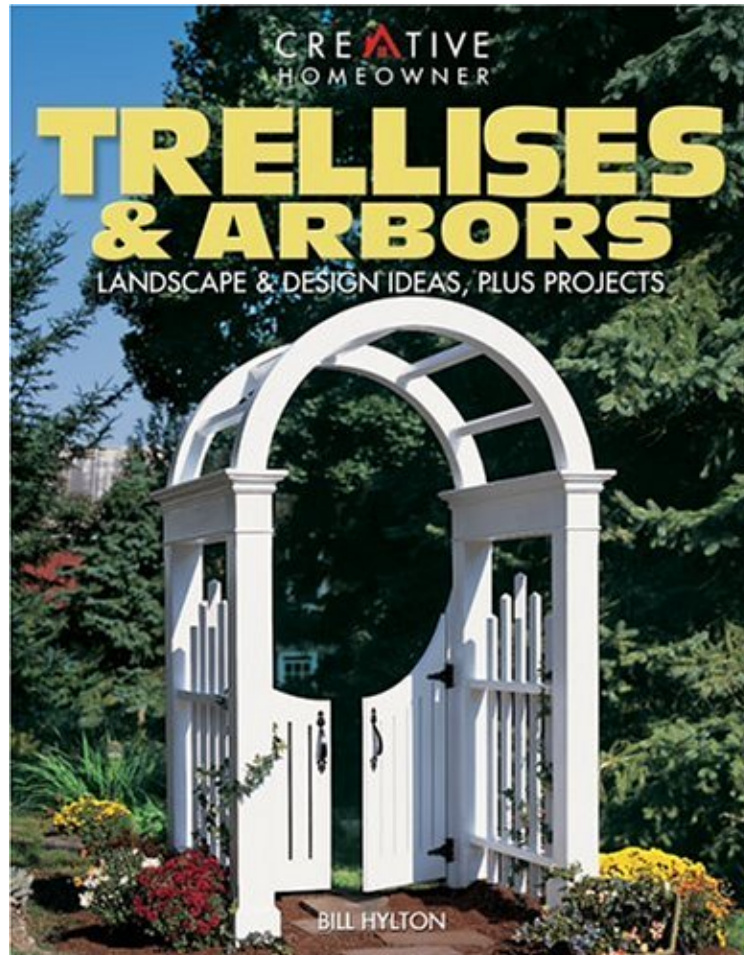

The real value of the book is in the high quality pictures and the ability to study the detail of the various designs. It's also a great way to see how certain designs fit into specific landscapes. So long as you buy the book expecting what I've described and you won't be disappointed. Number of pages is about right for a book of this type, meaning it's about as thick as a Cosmo magazine (maybe a bit more). It also is more of an intermediate to expert carpenter project book; I suspect most high intermediate and expert builders could easily take any of the ideas here and run with them. I, being somewhat of a novice carpenter, was looking for something a little more "by the numbers" for the arbors I would like to build. However, I am using the step by step trellis plans for one of the simpler trellises and it's very much "by the numbers".

With 352 color photos, elaborate step-by-step sequence shots, builder's tips, and complete material and cutting lists for every project, this is a must-have for the beginning or intermediate do-it-yourselfer looking to take on an outdoor landscape piece. Whether readers are complementing a garden in the backyard or trying to accentuate a walkway, Trellises Arbors has all the information and direction they'll need. There are 10 projects in all, ranging from a gateway arbor to a trellis bench, pergola, and fan trellis. There's even a photo- and information-packed section on plants to help readers select the perfect one to complete the project.
