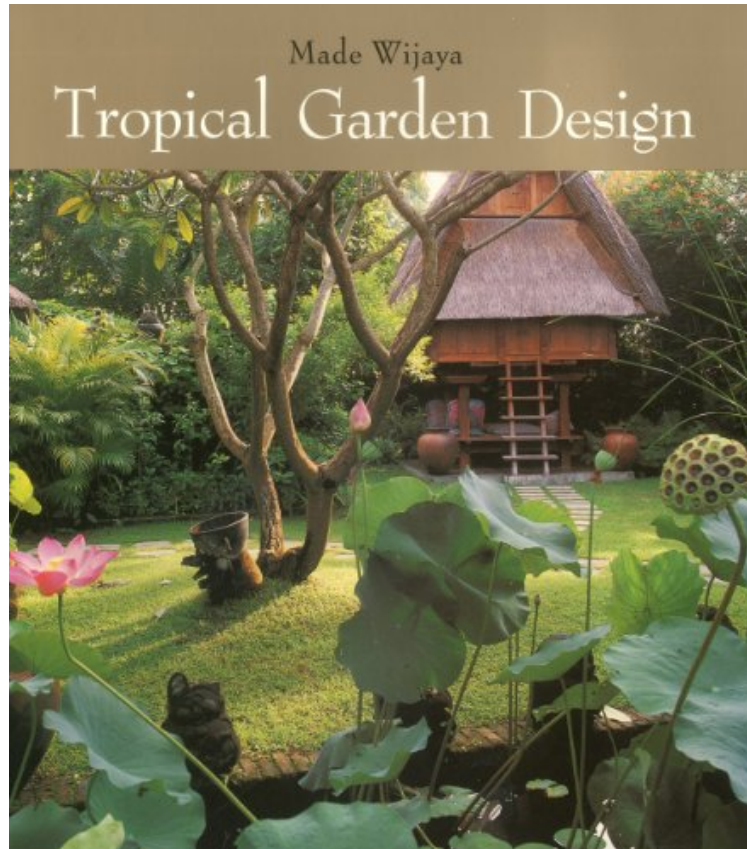

He arrived in Bali in 1973, having jumped ship and swum ashore in a rainstorm. A student of architecture, he intended the visit as a short break from his studies, but his fascination with Bali's rich culture and tradition led him to stay. A recognized authority on tropical gardens and

architecture, he has published several books, including *The Complete Stranger in Paradise* and *Architecture of Bali*: a source book of traditional and modern forms. He contributed to *Tropical Asian Style* and was the main author of a pocket guidebook to Bali. Made Wijaya also lectures on landscape design at the National University of Singapore, encouraging a new generation of architects and designers to view the making of tropical gardens as an art form.

PHOTOGRAPHERS Tim Street-Porter lives and works in Los Angeles with an 18th century second house in Connecticut 2hours from New York. He studied architecture in London before becoming a photographer. He moved to LA in 1979. He works regularly for a variety of design and travel magazines and was the principal photographer for a number of books.
