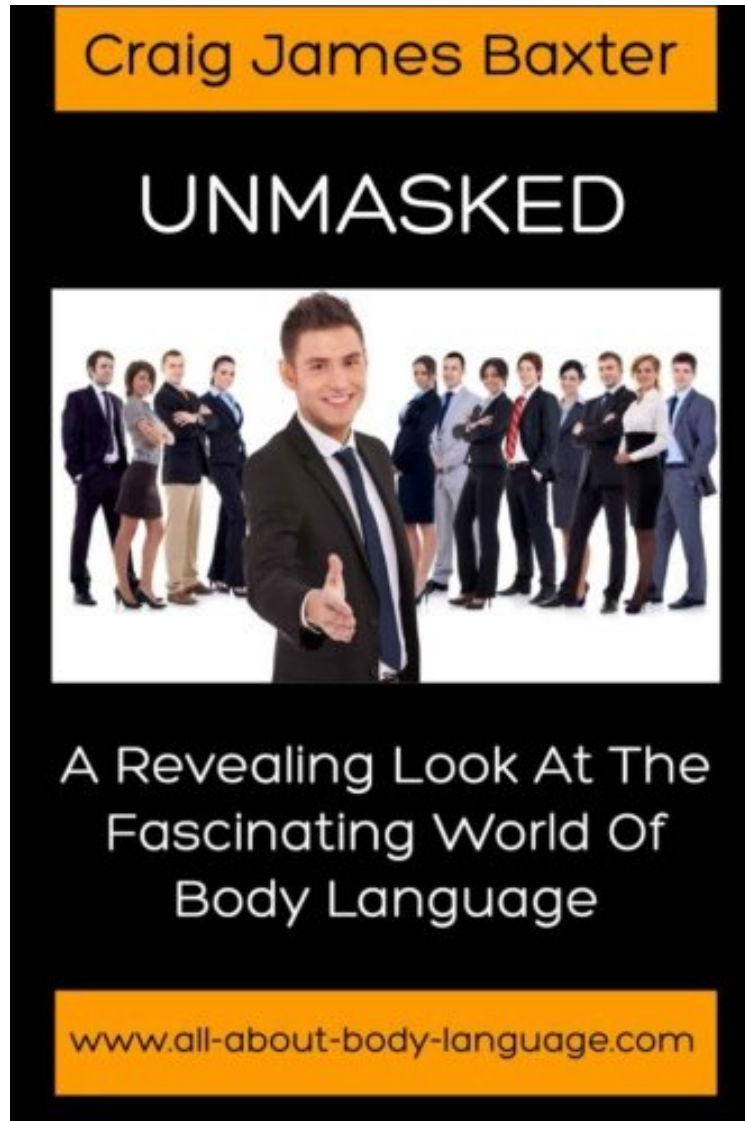

few examples of actual body language scenarios. It contends to debunk a few myths, and casually mentions a very few common gestures that are somewhat "universal". The book seems to be a generalization of the author's experiences, without getting into the actual details of body language and what and how we can learn from it. I am a bit surprised by this because the author's video reviews are much more specific- pointing out features like the lip press, asymmetrical body movements, etc. I was expecting a bit more of that here. There's little to no discussion regarding what kinds of things might differ when interviewing certain types of people, with the exception of lengthy eye contact. What kinds of behavior might a sociopath elicit as opposed to a liar? They don't feel fear or guilt- so those two benchmarks can't be used to gauge their honesty at all. Overall, disappointed, but I have respect for the author's skills and the book was a freebie, so I gave it two stars.

However, this book seemed to be mainly a reference to the author's other books on the same subject. A few interesting facts and examples were tucked into long speeches about what he would tell us in other chapters, and then telling us what he told us again. In other words, I felt this could have been told in one concise chapter instead of padding it in such obvious ways. The list of reference books and articles in the back is probably the most helpful part of the book.
