Curtains, rugs and linoleum are represented. Talented individuals who produced the embroidered masterpieces are shown. Each so talented as to give Morris's conceptions and ideas their final glory. Morris while brilliant could not have been as successful without the talents of family and employees who surrounded him. Every art form is represented. Watercolorists who painted the patterns created. Embroiderers who used the patterns. Weavers who figured out how to set up looms to use the patterns. Families who gathered talented women together to create works that often took years to finish. And then businessmen who understood the advantages and limitations for such arts and crafts creations, and who did not overwhelm the abilities of those working to reduce the quality of what was made.
