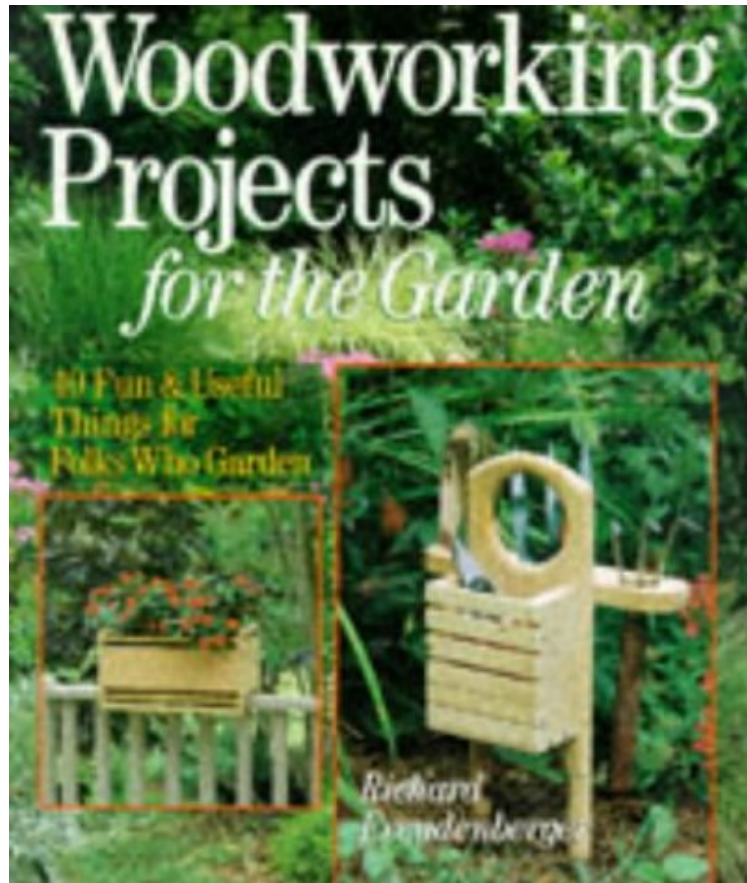

Most are made of cedar for weather resistance. Some are for the gardening, like the bean brace,

Needs Better Plans By christopheryeats This book is spoiled by poor plans for the projects. Here is an example: for the fire wood brace the cut list say 4 legs 3/3"x5-1/2"x36". So, should this board be a, say, 2x4, or maybe a 1x12. The book does not include this information on any of the projects.
